Tournament regulations

Mode: see group drawing

Tournament start: The tournament starts at 10 a.m., all participating teams have to register at the administration. We ask you to hand in the completed squad list as well as the players' licences at the registration.

Entitlement to play: Entitled to play are all players of the age group 2010 and younger.

Pitch: 3 pitches, matches will be played on a minimised half field (55x35 m), goals 2x5m

Playing time: The playing time is 15 min., the break between the matches is 5 min.

Number of players: 6 field players + 1 goalkeeper. Players can only be replaced during time-outs, reexchanges are allowed.

Strips: The colour of the strips will be announced with the squad list. If two teams have the same colour the second mentioned team has to change strips, wear the provided bibs respectively.

Kick-off, choice of ends: The first mentioned team has kick-off and plays in the rear half in direction of the stands.

Goalkeeper: The goalkeeper can only pick up the ball with his hands within the marked penalty box. The back-pass rule does not apply.

A shoot-out or throw-out beyond the centre line is not allowed, the ball has to touch the ground or a player in one's own half. A violation of this rule will be punished with an indirect free-kick at the centre line.

The goalkeeper can carry out the goal-kick by hand or by foot.

Corner, throw-in: Corners and throw-ins are played by foot, the throw-in is carried out indirectly.

Free-kick, penalty: Direct and indirect free-kicks are possible. Indirect free-kicks are awarded:

- 1) when the goalkeeper plays the ball beyond the centre line after having controlled the ball with his hand,
- 2) due to dangerous play and
- 3) when there is a goal-kick or a throw-in from the sideline.

The minimum distance of the opponents is 5m.

Penalties are carried out from the seven meters spot.

Disciplinary punishments: The referee can impose 2minutes penalties and red cards. A player can not be substituted during a 2minutes penalty. When a player is send off due to a red card he has to sit out the remaining playing time and can not be substituted. If the same player is booked for a red card twice in the course of the tournament, he will be excluded from the tournament.

Evaluation: In the group phase the most points in the final score count (the three points rule is applied). In case of a tie the ranking will be carried out as follows:

1. goal difference
2. number of goals scored
3. direct encounter
4. penalty shootout.

In case of a tie in the finals after the regular playing time a penalty shootout will be carried out.

Penalty shootout:

In case of a tie in the finals a penalty shootout will be carried out. Three players from each team compete against each other.

The player runs with the ball from the centre line towards the by the referee determined goal and tries to score. The attacking player is only allowed to move forwards, though slight sideways movements are possible. The player must not stop or run backwards, therefore he always has to be in running movement towards the goal. The action is considered terminated when the player has shot the ball at the goal, a follow-up shoot is not allowed. The action is therefore also terminated when the goalkeeper touches the ball e.g. when the attacker runs past, and the attacker gets into ball possession again. If the goalkeeper touches the ball and the ball passes the goal line without further touch by the attacker, a goal has to be given. Furthermore, a goal will be given when the attacker is fouled by the goalkeeper, or the goalkeeper touches the ball with his hand outside the penalty box.

If there is no winner after three players of each team, the penalty shootout continues in knock-out mode until a winner is found.

Incidentally the rules of the ÖFB apply.

In case of a dispute the tournament officials reserve the right to make the ultimate decision.

Liability: The organiser disclaims liability for possible injuries as well as for loss or damage of various objects.

You must obey the instructions of staff and members of the organiser!

Furthermore, we would like to point out the coaches' duty of supervision during the entire tournament!

Finally, SK Rapid Wien would like to wish all participants exciting and above all fair matches as well as an enjoyable stay in Vienna-Hütteldorf.
